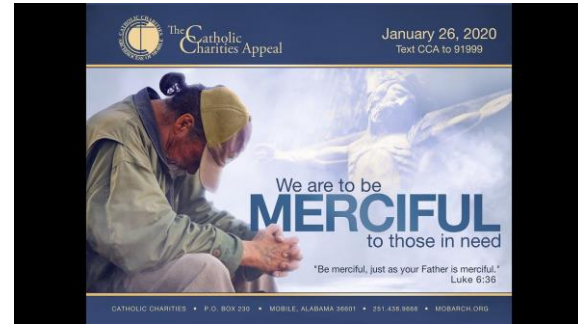

**FRANCIS IN FEBRUARY**

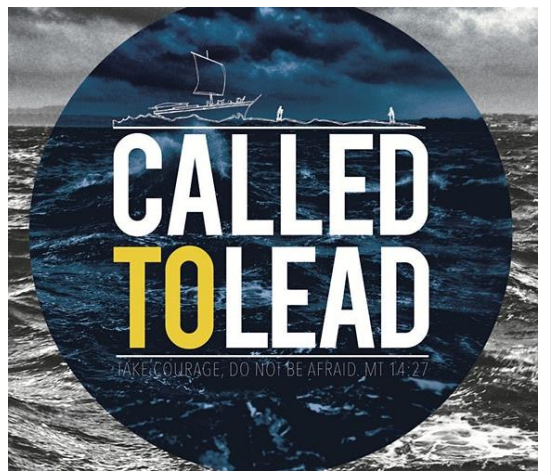

## CAMP CARDINAL

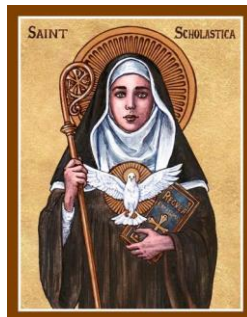
